Workshop Description

This program is the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) recognized Clinical Instructor Education and Credentialing Program. The program was developed through a grant funded by the APTA under the direction of principal investigator Michael J. Emery, Ed. D., PT, and co-investigators, Nancy Peatman, PT, Ed.D. and Lynn Ford, MS, M.Ed., PT, and the materials used by the New England Consortia of Academic Coordinators of Clinical Education, Inc.

Course Topics

- Planning and preparing for physical therapy students during their clinical education experiences
- Facilitating learning through questioning and effective feedback
- Developing skills of evaluation
- Identifying and managing students with exceptional situations
- Identifying legal implications for clinical educators, including issues presented by ADA legislation

Outcomes of the CIECP are measured through an Assessment Center for physical therapy providers. Participants apply information from the CIECP in six simulated situations. Upon receiving a passing score in each station in the Assessment Center, candidates will receive a Credentialed CI Certificate from the APTA.

Target Audience

The Course and Assessment Center is useful for both new and experienced physical therapist and physical therapist assistant educators involved with clinical education. While the information presented covers the basic skills for clinical instructors, the interactive tasks and large and small group discussions also benefit experienced clinical educators. Persons outside of physical therapy may participate in the educational program, but may not participate in the Assessment Center for credentialing.

Credits

P.G. Chambers School is registered as a provider with the New Jersey Department of Education, Provider/District Registration Number 1553. The APTA recognizes all physical therapists who successfully complete the course by a certificate of completion and inclusion on a roster of credentialed clinical instructors. Physical therapists and physical therapists assistants who successfully complete the course receive 15 contact hours, including 12 hours of educational material and a three-hour Assessment Center.
