- Prepares and maintains accurate written nursing reports, immunization records, and medical records.
- Attends daily classroom meetings for student updates.
- On an as needed basis will assess students in Kids Count Child Care for any
 injury; illness; concerns; brought to the attention of P.G. Chambers nursing staff
 by Kids Count Staff. Appropriate treatment, consistent with child care regulations,
 will be provided to the student and parent contact will be initiated by the Kids
 Count Staff.
